



Citrus Variety Fact Sheet

‘OLL-4’

‘OLL-4’ produces high quality sweet oranges with excellent internal and external quality, with exceptional juice color scores, juice content, and soluble solids. Fruit of ‘OLL-4’ holds on the tree exceptionally well, and maintains quality into the summer. The juice flavor profile of ‘OLL-4’ has been rated as good or better than ‘Valencia’ by Tropicana. Although minimal formal yield data is available, ‘OLL-4’ has been the highest yielding tree among the OLL (Ori Lee Late) somaclones.

Harvest	Trees mature in the standard Valencia season. During some years, harvest can begin a few weeks earlier than ‘Valencia’, depending on weather.
Tree Characteristics	Trees of ‘OLL-4’ exhibit improved cold and drought tolerance over industry standard oranges, and do not seem to exhibit alternate bearing.
Yield	‘OLL-4’ has been the highest yielding tree among the OLL (Ori Lee Late) somaclones.
