AlbusTM 'FL11-51'

AlbusTM 'FL11-51' is a vigorous, early-season, high-yielding cultivar, released by the University of Florida in 2022. It has high yield in the evergreen system in Central Florida, with additional data to be gathered for performance in South Central Florida. Fruit is firm with a heavy wax bloom, and received high scores in consumer taste panels. No disease issues have been observed to date.
